- Add the Family Violence Prevention Fund as a beneficiary of your workplace giving program
- Check to see if your employer has a matching gifts program
- Establish a fund raising competition between grade levels/workplace departments. Each school grade/department comes up with a different fundraising idea and whoever raises the most money for the GIVE RESPECT! Campaign wins a prize. (e.g., an auction, a bake sale, a car wash, a concert, etc.)
